Personal

- Twentieth president of Hamline University, Minnesota's first institution of higher learning
- Second female president, first person of color

Professional

- Oversaw enrollment of Hamline's largest first-year class in its history (2019)
- Guided university through COVID-19 pandemic with no cuts to faculty or class offerings
- Established balanced budgets during her entire tenure
- Added faculty to the Facilities and Academic and Student Affairs Committees
- Created three new committees to hear faculty voices in addition to shared governance
- Hamline's first-generation and students of color proportions are at all-time high levels and among the best in the region
- Established the first Distinguished Professorship in the university's history, an honor that went to David Schultz
- Served as Chairman of the NCAA Division III Presidents' Council (2021)
- Increased salaries of full professors and amount received for promotion to a higher rank—this addressed salary depression that occurred due to the financial crisis that occurred in 2008-2009.
- Leading the university's comprehensive campaign, which was started when I became president of Hamline. We are on track to exceed our campaign goal.
- Nominated and supported an emeritus faculty to serve on the Board of Trustees to provide understanding of the role of faculty in university issues.
- Supported the addition of a student representative to the board's Academic and Student Affairs Committee.
