Bruce OHR, date of birth (DOB) [REDACTED] [REDACTED], currently the Associate Deputy Attorney General and Director of the Department of Justice's Organized Crime and Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) was interviewed at FBI Headquarters. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

[REDACTED] OHR met STEELE [REDACTED] in 2007, sometime before a January 2008 conference they both attended. OHR remembers he was at a conference when Simeon Mogilevich was arrested in Russia in January 2008 and their first interaction took place prior to that event. As the Chief of DOJ's Organized Crime and Racketeering Section at the time, OHR met STEELE [REDACTED] in London FGI [REDACTED]. STEELE [REDACTED] was an expert on Russia, specifically Russian organized crime, and was concerned the west was not taking the Russian threat seriously. Russian oligarchs are brilliant yet cold-blooded and do not act like adults as they kill people for nothing. Over the years OHR and STEELE [REDACTED] had a few more meetings before OHR FGI [REDACTED] and joined or founded Orbis. FGI [REDACTED] OHR and STEELE [REDACTED] would see each other once a year in London or the U.S. STEELE [REDACTED] had paid clients, yet provided OHR with the same short intel reports from a variety of subsources that were well placed. OHR introduced STEELE [REDACTED] to his eventual handler, SA Michael Gaeta from the FBI's New York Field office.

[REDACTED] OHR believes that STEELE [REDACTED] kept his sources FGI [REDACTED] OHR does not know if STEELE [REDACTED] kept the sources but there was a strong context that he/she did keep the sources and that is what OHR drew from it.

[REDACTED] OHR believes Russian oligarchs will provide information to the FBI because in Russia everyone talks to the police. Following the 2014 Ukrainian invasion OHR met with Gaeta and STEELE in Rome. OHR recalled the three talked about engaging with prospective oligarchs, and that meeting led to a meeting between the FBI, Paul Hauser and Russian oligarch Oleg Deripaska in New York.

(U [REDACTED]) In the 2011 timeframe, STEELE introduced the FBI to the source that predicated the FIFA case. The source may not have been the source who initiated the case, but contributed to the start of the case.

[REDACTED] In late July 2016, possibly Saturday, July 30, 2016, STEELE called OHR and asked to meet for breakfast as he/she was in Washington, D.C. and had some serious stuff to talk about. STEELE planned to also tell SA Gaeta about the information he/she had collected. OHR met STEELE for breakfast where OHR was told that Carter Page had met with high level officials in Russia. Page met with Sechin and one other person. The media had already documented Page's trip to Moscow at that time. The FSB had Trump over a barrel according to a high level Russian official who advised former SVR Director Vyacheslav Trubnikov who reported to STEELE. In addition, Oleg Deripaska was furious at Paul Manafort and was making a case against him. Deripaska and Hauser were almost ready to talk to the U.S. about the money Paul Manafort stole. STEELE claimed he had already given some of this reporting to SA Gaeta and planned to give the rest to him. At that time, STEELE had provided Gaeta with two reports regarding these topics while Glen Simpson had four. OHR provided copies of notes he took during and after the meeting with STEELE which are enclosed as attachments.

[REDACTED] OHR knew Glen Simpson hired STEELE to dig up Trump's connections to Russia. OHR's wife is a Russian translator and was hired to conduct open source research. Even though she did not know the goal of the project, she was able to surmise the purpose as the individuals she was researching were close to Trump. OHR knew that Glen Simpson was hired by a lawyer who does opposition research. OHR knew STEELE's reporting on Trump's ties to Russia were going to the Clinton Campaign, Jon Winer at the U.S. State Department and the FBI. OHR was aware that Simpson was passing STEELE's information to many individuals or entities and at times STEELE would attend meetings with Simpson.

[REDACTED] OHR met STEELE in Washington, D.C. in late September, possibly close to the time when the Yahoo news article was published on September 23, 2016. During that meeting, STEELE advised the Alfa server in the US is a link to the Trump campaign and Sergei Millian's Russian/American organization in the U.S. used the Alfa server two weeks

prior. Sergei Yatsenko is alleged to be an Intelligence Officer working with Carter Page. STEELE was desperate that Donald Trump not get elected and was passionate about him not being the U.S. President. OHR believes STEELE wanted to blunt or foil the Kremlin's plans. Simpson and STEELE could have met with Yahoo or Michael Isikoff jointly, but OHR does not know if they did. OHR provided copies of notes he took after the meeting with STEELE which are enclosed as attachments.

[REDACTED] OHR never believed STEELE was making up information or shading it. He/she would say this is what sources are telling me. There are always Russian conspiracy theories that come from the Kremlin. One time OHR heard a theory from STEELE regarding Mikhail Lesin's death that came from the Kremlin. STEELE reported that Lesin was beaten to teach him a lesson but it got out of hand and he died. OHR honestly believes STEELE reported what he heard from sources at the Kremlin but that doesn't make that story true.

[REDACTED] Jon Winer possibly knew STEELE FGI [REDACTED] OHR met Winer in 1999 or 2000 when Winer was the U.S. Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for International Law Enforcement. Winer was very interested in Russian Organized Crime and enthusiastic about the subject, yet at times difficult to deal with. OHR knew Glen Simpson and others were talking to Victoria Nuland at the U.S. State Department.

[REDACTED] OHR does not know how STEELE handles or communicates with his/her sub-sources. OHR does not know the identity of STEELE's sub-sources.

[REDACTED] OHR has never met the business partner of STEELE [REDACTED]. On one occasion, OHR met with STEELE [REDACTED] and the CHS brought a tall, young, male associate, but it was not the CHS' business partner.

[REDACTED] OHR does not know what STEELE [REDACTED] s spouse's position FGI [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] OHR has never been present during meetings between STEELE [REDACTED] and Jon Winer. OHR is only aware that STEELE [REDACTED] and Winer have met as STEELE [REDACTED] advises OHR that the meetings occur.

[REDACTED] Glen Simpson directed STEELE [REDACTED] to speak to the press as that was what Simpson was paying STEELE [REDACTED] to do. OHR does not know if STEELE [REDACTED] going to Mother Jones was Simpson's idea or not.

[REDACTED] Glen Simpson hired OHR's wife to conduct research for his firm. OHR will voluntarily provide his wife's research to the FBI. OHR provided the interviewing Agent with a report on Paul Manafort. The report titled, "Manafort Chronology", was scanned and is a digital attachment to this document.

After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

[REDACTED] OHR had breakfast at Peet's Coffee, 11th and E St. NW, Washington, D.C. with Glenn Simpson at 10:00 A.M. on December 10, 2016. During breakfast Simpson provided OHR with an 8GB Verbatim USB micro digital media drive (thumb drive). OHR does not know what is on the thumb drive but believes it is in regards to the work STEELE [REDACTED] was hired to do for Simpson. The thumb drive was entered into evidence at WFO as original evidence (bar code # E5518001) and a working copy CD-ROM was produced for investigative use. An evidence FD-302 was generated and serialized to this file.

[REDACTED] OHR took notes after the meeting with Simpson to preserve his memory and referred to them during the interview. OHR's notes are an attachment to this document.

[REDACTED] Simpson identified Michael Cohen, a lawyer in Brooklyn, NY as having many Russian clients in the Brighton Beach, NY area. Cohen is the go-between Russia and the Trump Campaign and replaced Paul Manafort and Carter Page. Cohen's wife's last name is Shusterman and her father is a major real-estate developer in Moscow with ties to the Kremlin. Cohen may have attended a meeting in Prague, possibly in September, regarding the Trump Campaign and the Russians.

[REDACTED] According to Simpson, much of his collection about the Trump campaign ties to Russia comes from a former Russian Intelligence officer who lives in the U.S. Simpson does not know his name.

[REDACTED] A former Trump campaign official, possibly Rick Wilson, was talking about some of the Trump ties to Russia and the Trump Campaign tried to sue him for violating his non-disclosure agreement.

[REDACTED] A Russian senator and mobster named Torshin may be involved in running the Central Bank of Russia. Torshin's name comes up in in Law Enforcement Organized Crime circles as he is well known in a famous Spanish case that shows direct linkages between Russian Organized Crime, Torshin and the Russian Government. Torshin may have funneled Russian money to the National Rifle Association (NRA) to use in support of Trump. An NRA lawyer, Cleta Mitchell, found out about the money pipeline and was very upset, but the election was over by the time she learned of it. Simpson stated there are pictures or Torshin with Trump. Simpson provided OHR with an article on the NRA and Torsion. The article is an attachment to this document.

[REDACTED] Some of Simpson's staff believe the NRA spent an abnormally large amount of money during the election, possibly indicating Russian involvement, but others in his company disagree.

[REDACTED] The New York Times story from October 3, 2016, that downplayed the connection between Alfa Bank servers and the Trump campaign was incorrect. There was communication and it wasn't spam. Mikhail Fridman lied in the written statement that he gave to the New York Times and Washington Post. Fridman claimed he never met Trump, however there are pictures to the contrary.

[REDACTED] Simpson received a bizarre tip on December 9 that the initial impetus to look at Anthony Weiner's computer came from FGI [REDACTED]. Simpson is not sure whether to believe this.

[REDACTED] Simpson still thinks Sergei Millian is a key figure connecting Trump to Russia. Looking at Millian led Simpson's company to Cohen. Simpson would be surprised if Millian was still in the U.S. Simpson believes Millian is an SVR officer, however he is deducing this from Millian's alias, not because he was told Millian was SVR. Millian may have overseen many financial transfers from Russia to assist the Trump campaign.

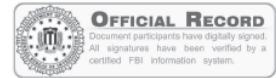

[REDACTED] OHR asked Simpson if he was concerned about his personal safety. Simpson responded that he learned from his Russian investigative reporting what they were capable of but there was no way for him to know if they were coming after him. Simpson mentioned that someone called and asked him to find out where all of the Alfa Bank stories were coming from. Simpson did not state this was a threat from the Russians, but that was the impression made upon OHR based upon the timing of the comment and using that story as a response to OHR's question.

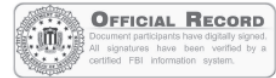

After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Special Agent and Intelligence Analyst and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

██████████ On January 20, 2017, OHR received an e-mail from Glen Simpson asking OHR to contact Simpson. OHR subsequently contacted Simpson telephonically. During the telephonic conversation, Simpson told OHR that one of Christopher Steele's employees has been identified and will likely be publicly named by the media within the next couple of days. Simpson did not know the identity or contact information of the employee, only that the employee was intimately involved in compiling the information contained within the dossier on Donald J. Trump and the Trump campaign. Due to the sensitive nature of the employee's work and contacts, revealing the identity of the employee could place the employee in danger. Simpson was considering putting the employee in contact with an attorney to advise the employee. When OHR asked for more information regarding the employee and the nature of the threat, Simpson replied he would contact Steele for more information and then re-contact OHR.

██████████ In the early hours of January 21, 2017, OHR received a text message from Steele which OHR did not notice until later in the morning. Around 8:00 am on the same day, OHR received call from Steele. During this conversation Steele relayed his concerns regarding the safety of his

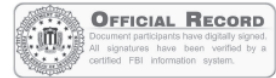

the employee's name was released, the employee "may need help quickly." Steele has been unable to directly contact the employee but observed a recent Facebook posting from the employee, indicating the employee was alright. When asked for the employee's identity, Steele replied that he did not have the employee's permission to share the information, but if contact was needed, a British female, not affiliated with the British Government, whom Steele identified as "FH" and was known to both Steel and OHR could arrange contact. Steele believed the employee, who resided in the Washington, DC metropolitan area, would be scared if the US Government contacted the employee; the employee's natural inclination would be to 'lay low.'

[REDACTED] In addition to the publication of the employee's name, an individual Steele identified as "SM" was about to be exposed (NFI) in the public which would also lead to the employee being identified. SM was someone from whom the employee obtained information, the nature of which was singular and thus traceable back to the employee.

[REDACTED] Steele also told OHR that he spoke with a staff member of Senator John McCain's office sometime prior to October 2016. Steele had this conversation at the request of Anthony Wood. Since October 2016, Steele had not spoken to anyone regarding the Trump dossier.

██████████ On January 24, 2017, OHR received a WhatsApp notification from Christopher Steele. On January 25, 2017, Steele contacted and spoke with OHR via WhatsApp. During this conversation, Steele again relayed his concerns regarding the safety of his employee. Due to the possibility of the employee's identity being exposed by the media, the employee had 'went to ground' but recently 'semi-emerged' (NFI) indicating Steele could establish contact. Steele's concern was exacerbated by additional media reporting on "SM." SM was someone from whom the employee obtained information, the nature of which was singular and thus traceable back to the employee. Steele commented that SM had been previously mentioned in the media, "FT" (presumed by OHR to be the Financial Times) during the summer of 2016. Steele re-iterated to OHR the employee was an "absolute gem." Steele would attempt contact with the employee on 26 January 2017 to "see where he is." After Steele spoke with the employee, Steele would re-contact OHR.

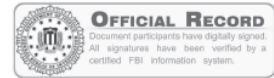

██████████ Bruce OHR, date of birth (DOB) ██████████ ██████████, currently the Associate Deputy Attorney General and Director of the Department of Justice's Organized Crime and Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) was interviewed at FBI Headquarters, 935 Pennsylvania Ave., Washington, DC. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Special Agents and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

██████████ OHR stated he had been contacted by Christopher Steele, via WhatsApp, on January 31, 2017. On January 30, 2017, the Trump Administration fired Acting Attorney General Sally Q. Yates and Steele had contacted OHR to determine if OHR anticipated being fired as well and, if so, who in the Department of Justice could he continue to reach out to. OHR added that he had previously explained to Steele at some point, his contact with the U.S. Government would have to involve the FBI. Interviewing agents asked OHR to ask Steele if he would be comfortable getting the name of an FBI agent.

██████████ OHR advised Kathleen Kavalec, Deputy Assistant Secretary, Bureau of European and Eurasian Affairs, U.S. Department of State would be meeting with French representatives in order to discuss potential Russian influence in their upcoming Presidential elections. OHR reminded the interviewing agents Kavalec did speak with Steele several times prior to the 2016 US Presidential election and believed Steele's reporting to have generated from mainly one source.

██████████ OHR also advised Adam Waldman, an attorney representing Oleg Vladimirovich Deripaska, explained his client felt as if his productive conversations with OGA ██████████ were recently complicated by the FBI, who he

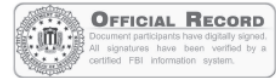

~~felt viewed him as a criminal. Waldman informed OHR that Deripaska would~~

like to 'clean things up' and felt the circumstances surrounding the 2016 US Presidential election had become 'too emotional.' OHR stated, as he understood it, Deripaska was informed of what was required during the FBI interview.

[REDACTED] OHR stated Waldman also discussed WikiLeaks founder Julian Assange's proffer with DOJ in order to obtain safe passage to the United States. In return, Assange would (1) be willing to step down from his role at WikiLeaks, (2) disclose his newest information to the U.S. Government and accept recommendations for redactions, and (3) discuss the information obtained from the cyber intrusion of the Democratic National Committee. According to Waldman, Assange still refuses to identify his source, but is frustrated the Russian Federation is getting credit for the intrusion. OHR added that proffer request had been passed do DOJ National Security Division.

After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Special Agents and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

██████████ OHR stated he had been contacted by Christopher Steele, via WhatsApp and OHR responded via FaceTime on 02/11/2017.

██████████ Steele advised OHR that his contact was still doing well and he was going to continue to monitor his situation. If it helped to identify the contact, OHR added he has a five year old daughter, who is a U.S. Citizen.

██████████ Steele's company is continuing to work for both Paul Hausser, another attorney for Oleg Deripaska, and German client, Bilfinger. However, OHR explained Steele is beginning to worry about his business and was preparing a report on Edward Snowden to broker a business relationship with the FBI. Steele advised OHR, 'You may see me re-emerge in a couple of weeks.'

██████████ OHR responded he had yet to ask Steele if he would like to be provided with an FBI contact.

██████████ OHR also advised Steele's family was doing fine, but were still a bit "freaked out." However, it seemed to Steele that things were calming down and he was pleased about a recent CNN article that stated U.S.

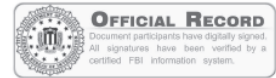

██████████ OHR stated he had recently been contacted by Christopher Steele on three separate occasions via WhatsApp or FaceTime. On 12 March 2017, Steele told OHR he was concerned about receiving a letter from Senator Grassley asking Steele to disclose additional details regarding the dossier Steele compiled on Donald J. Trump. Steele also expressed concern about the well-being of one of his previous employees who was instrumental in obtaining the information published in the dossier.

██████████ On 15 March 2017, Steele told OHR if asked, Steele would tell the investigating congressional committees what he could about the dossier, but Steele must protect the sources and methods used to collect the information.

██████████ On 26 March 2017, Steele told OHR he expected a letter from the congressional committee investigation at any moment. Steele was aware that Glen Simpson has already revived such a letter. Steele further told OHR that Adam Waldman, an attorney representing Oleg Vladimirovich Deripaska, was acting in an informal capacity with Senator Mark Warner's staff, and was in contact with Steele. On 5/8/2017, SA [redacted] and SSA [redacted] interviewed BRUCE OHR, date of birth (DOB) [redacted], currently the Associate Deputy Attorney General and Director of the Department of Justice's Organized Crime and Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) at FBI Washington Field Office, 601 4th Street, Washington, DC. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing agents and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

OHR and STEELE communicated via text message in WhatsApp and arranged a call for 5/3/2017 at 8:00 AM. STEELE told OHR that business was good.

STEELE had been worried about Director Comey's upcoming testimony to congress, especially his response to questions that would be raised by Representative Grassley. STEELE was specifically concerned about anything Director Comey would say that might expose a sensitive source. STEELE was happy with Director Comey's response.

In a previous conversation, STEELE had expressed concern for the well-being of a source. STEELE described the current disposition of this source as "stable".

STEELE informed OHR that the disclosure laws in the UK were more narrow than in the United States and therefore limited his ability to testify before Congress. FGI [redacted]

DAN JONES was a former FBI employee and had been on the staff of the Senate Intelligence Committee. At the time of the interview, JONES was working with the DEMOCRACY INITIATIVE PROJECT and was still in touch with the FBI.

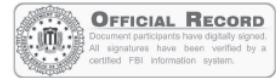

STEELE contacted OHR via Whatsapp at 9:45 AM on Monday, 5/15/2017. STEELE said that his wife and his business partner were both ok with him talking to the FBI.

SSA [redacted] told OHR that he would communicate with headquarters regarding FBI agents meeting with STEELE and let him know when he received a response.
