
**NOTICE OF IMPENDING DISMISSAL FOR WANT OF PROSECUTION**

The Georgia Court of Appeals having disqualified the entirety of the Fulton County District Attorney's Office from further handling of this case,<sup>1</sup> the duty falls on the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council ("PAC") to identify a replacement. *See* O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5. Should an appointed prosecuting attorney or representative of PAC fail to file an entry of appearance or request a particularized extension within 14 days from the entry of this Notice, the Court will issue a dismissal without prejudice for want of prosecution. *See Walker v. State*, 312 Ga. 640, 644 (2021).
