All are welcome here.

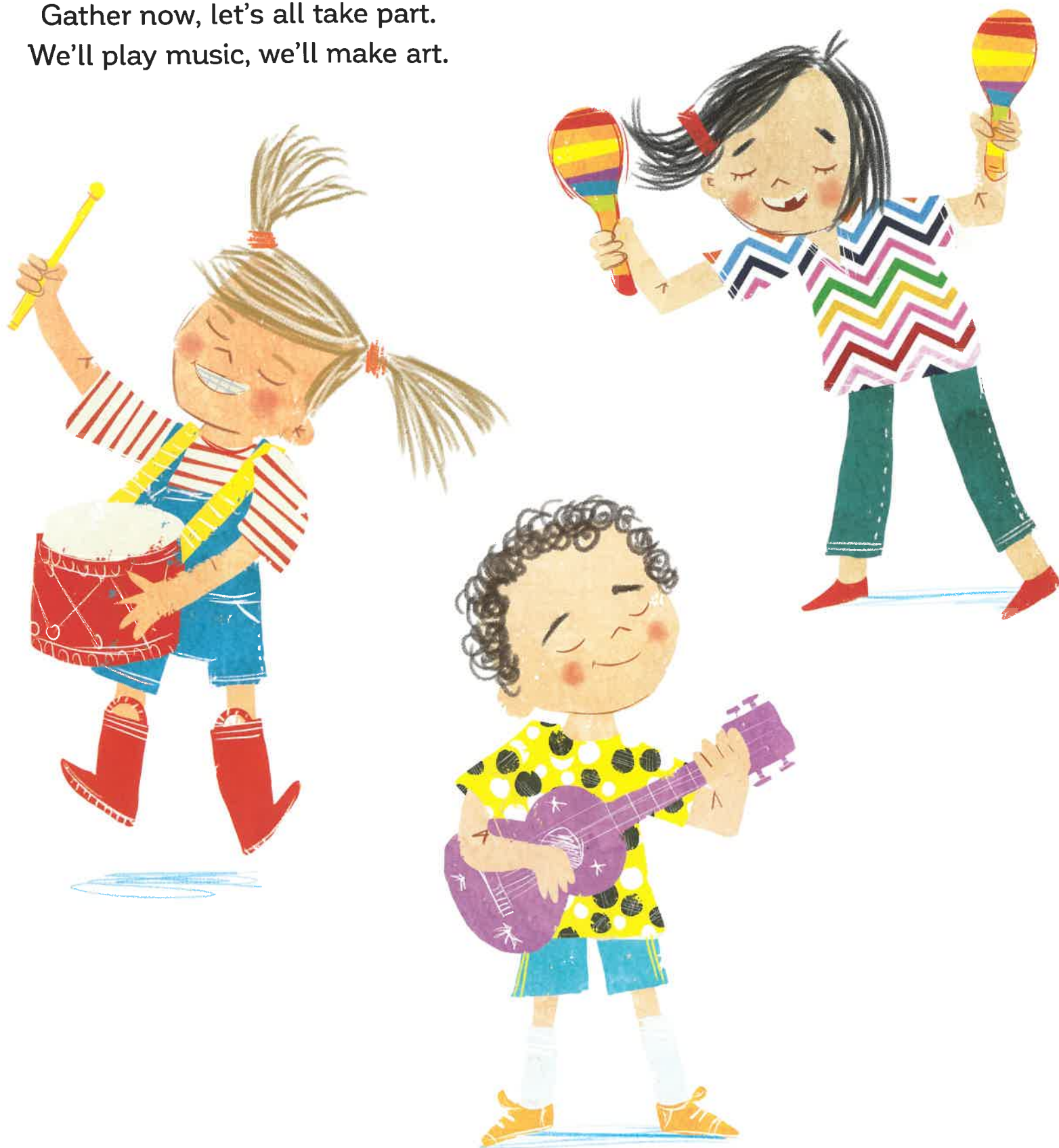

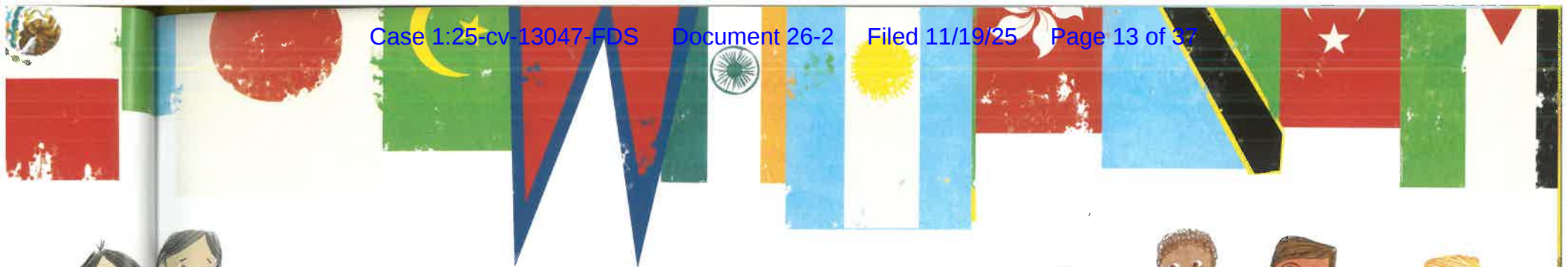

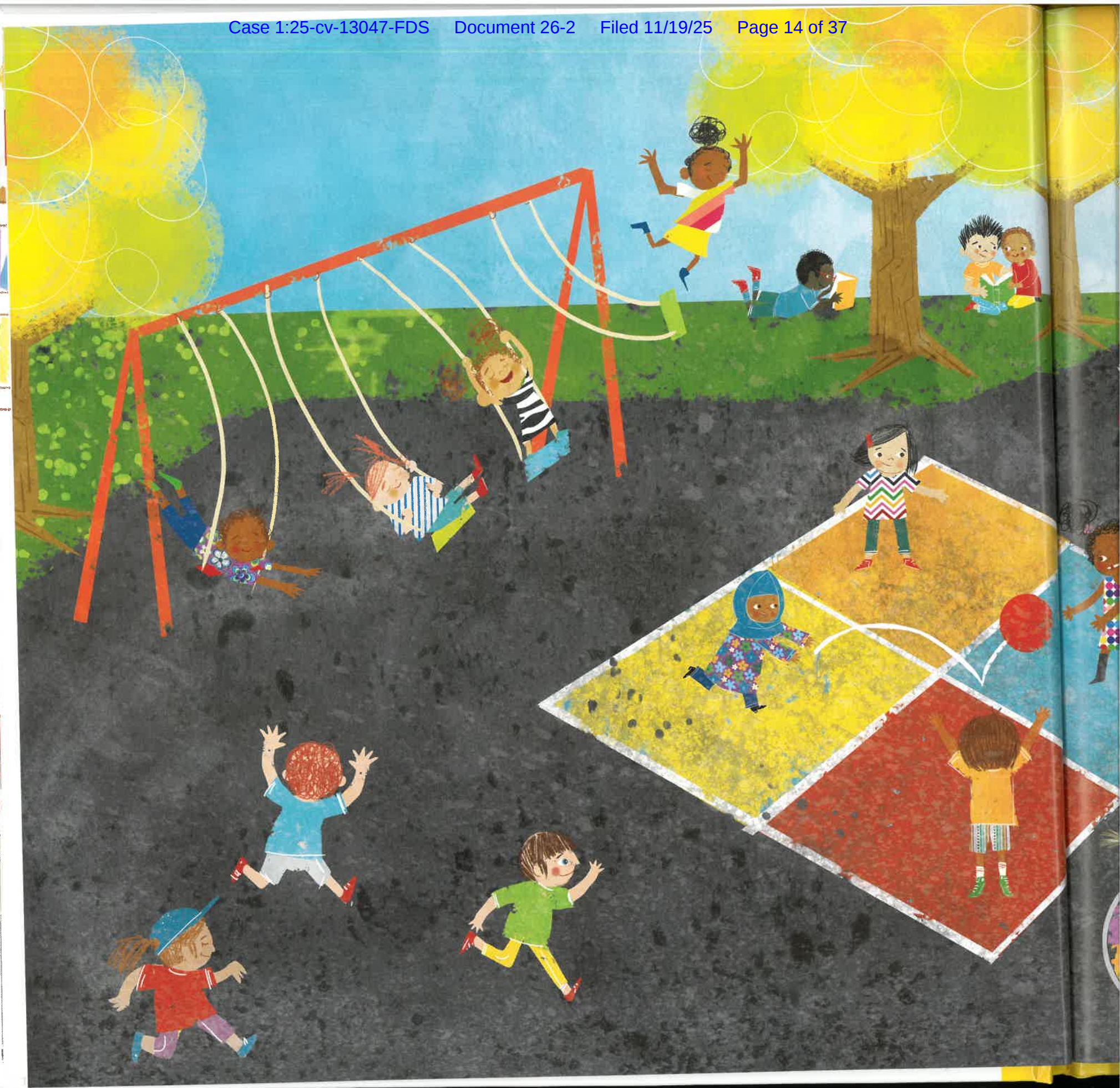

Pass it around till everyone's fed.





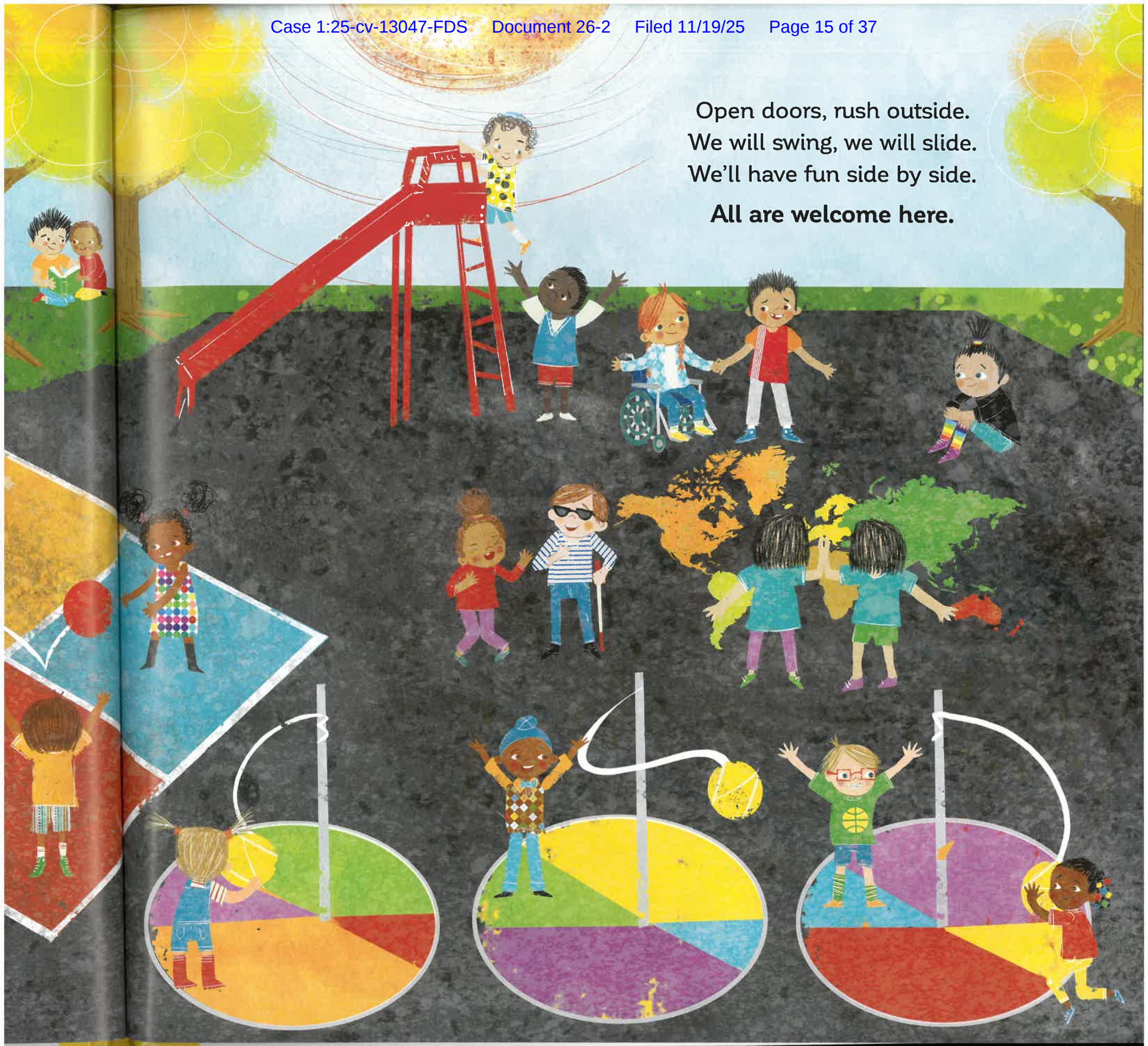

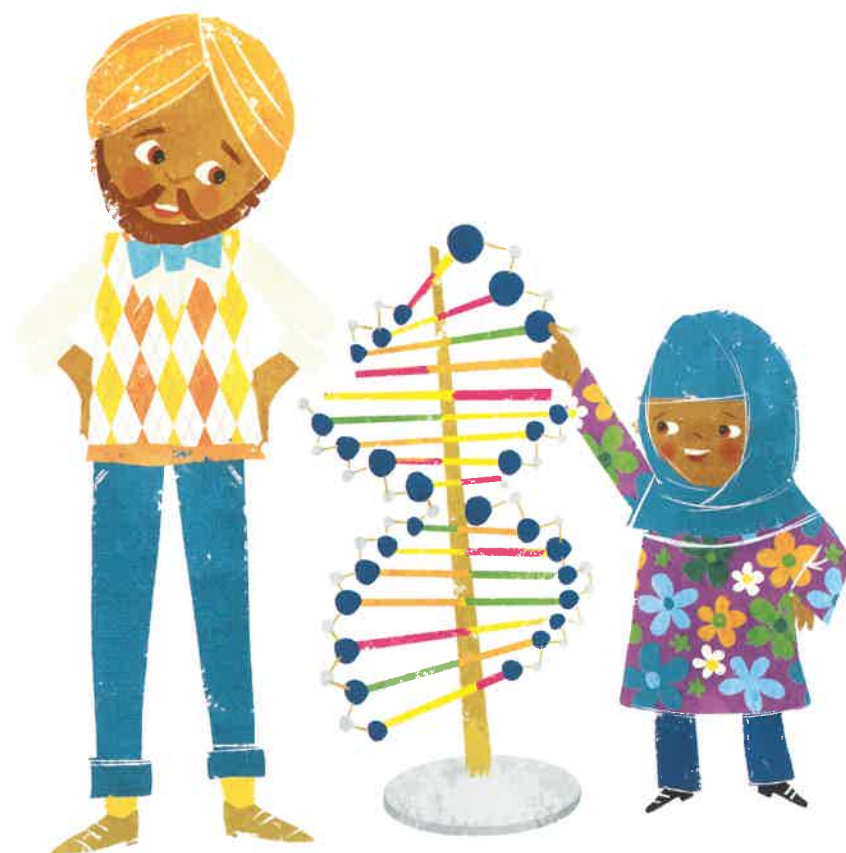


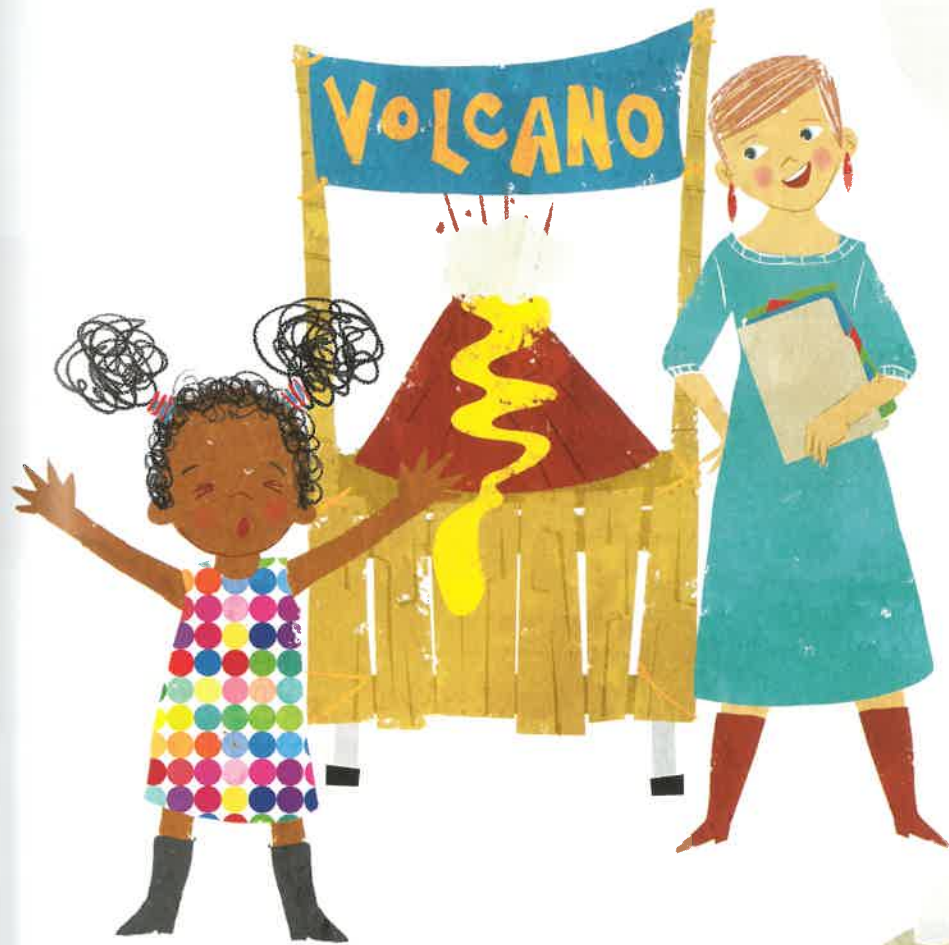
